Rules and conditions of entry.

1. **Liability Clause:** *The organiser has taken reasonable precautions to ensure the health and safety of everyone present. For those measures to be effective everyone must take all precautions to avoid and prevent accidents occurring and must obey the instructions of the organiser and all the officials and stewards.*
2. *Ponies must be registered with the Shetland Pony Stud Book Society, other than in Classes which are open to Unregistered ponies.*
3. *The decision of the judge is final.*
4. ***Entry forms must be signed and accompanied by the correct fee. Cheques made payable to SWWSPG.***
5. *Please do not drop litter, and, if you see any, please be considerate and pick it up.*

Classes

1. **Leading rein.** Registered & Unregistered ponies 4 yrs & over. Riders 8 yrs & under. Snaffle bridles, lead rein affixed to nose band. Rosettes to all. Special rosette to the best unregistered pony.
2. **First ridden.** Registered and unregistered ponies 4 yrs & over, riders 11 years and under. Rosettes to all. Special rosette to the best Unregistered pony.
3. **Open Ridden.** Registered & unregistered ponies 4 yrs & over, riders any age. Rosettes to all. Special rosette to the best unregistered pony.

Championship for 1st & 2nd from classes 1-3

4. **Best Condition & Turnout** –16 years and under in hand or under saddle
5. **Best condition & Turnout** –open
6. **Unregistered in hand** –ponies any height or colour.
7. **Gelding.** Any height and colour, 3 years and over.
8. **Gelding** –Any height or colour 4 years old and over
9. **Novice.** Ponies any age, height and colour, never to have won a first prize at any show
10. **Best Veteran in hand.** Ponies 15 years and over. First placed rosette awarded to Best mare and Best male. Registered ponies only

MY LITTLE PONY CHAMPIONSHIP for 1st and 2nd from classes 4-10

The following classes 11 to 23 are open to registered ponies only

11. **Child handler-Handlers** to be 16 years and under. Judged on handlers ability to show their pony. Classes will be split if entries warrant. Entries open to all.

BLACKS

12. **Colt , filly or Gelding 2 or 3 year old.**
13. **Colt ,filly or Gelding Yearling**
14. **Mare or Gelding. 4 years and over.**
15. **Entire male/Stallion. 4 years and over.**

Championship: First and second from classes 12 to 15

COLOUREDS

16. **Colt, filly or Gelding. 2 or 3 year old.**
17. **Colt, filly or Gelding. Yearling.**
18. **Mare or Gelding. 4 year old and over.**
19. **Entire male/ Stallion. 4 years old and over.**

Championship first and second from classes 16 to 19

Miniature (Not to exceed 34” at maturity)

20. **Colt, filly or Gelding. 2 or 3 years old.**
21. **Colt, filly or Gelding Yearlings.**
22. **Mare or Gelding . 4 Years and over.**
23. **Entire Male/Stallion. 4 years and over.**

Championship first and second from Classes 20 to 23

SHOW CHAMPION – Champion of Classes 1-3 and Champion Black, Coloureds and Miniatures. Rosettes for Show Champion and Reserve Champion.
